

It is a co-education institution dedicated to impart education and groom the personality of its students. It is a secular instituion and welcomes the pupils of all caste, creed & religion.

The School is affiliated to the prestigious I.C.S.E. Council, New Delhi and the entire curriculum is based on the patterns approved by the Council. Keeping in view the commitment to provide quality education, the school has a standard procedure to screen the candidates desirous of taking admission.

The School has a mission of making this institution a centre of excellence in school & College education and fulfilling the needs & expectations of students, parents & society at large. It aims at nurturing of talent and building a learning environment and to promote creativity and innovation. The School believes that truthfulness and sincerity that it inculcates in its students shall make them into a responsible citizen and a good human being.

The School invites admission from Nursery to class XII. The school academic session begins from April and ends in March. Duly filled admission forms must be submitted to the office and candidates may have to appear for the admission test.

It is the sole authority of the Principal to admit or reject any student without having to assign the reasons. The school imparts education in Science (PCM/PCB) & Commerce disciplines at 10+2 level, it has well equipped laboratories for the Science & Computer Classes. Due care is taken to familiarize the students with the required knowledge of theory & practical studies.

The school in collaboration with the national reputed newspaper THE_TIMES_OF INDIA, has participated in "Newspaper in Education (NIE) programme of the Times of India, whereby each student from class V onwards is provided with a copy of the newspaper on working days at subsidised prices. The teachers ensure in the home assignments that students go through the news paper at home, which shall improve their command over language and aware them of their surroundings.

The school provides facilities of Canteen, Book Shop & Dress shop in its premises which caters to the needs and requirement of the students. It is ensured that the eatables in the canteen are prepared in hygienic conditions and are available during lunch hours at reasonable price. School dress and accessories are made available to the students at reasonable prices from the dress shop on all working day.

Text books prescribe in the school according to the ICSE New Delhi Curriculum may be purchased from the School Book Shop. Students are expected to buy the stationery from the school shop, so as to avoid confusion in the text books later on. The academic session of school runs from April to March, The final examination is conducted in March and new session begins from first week of April.

First term and half-yearly examination are held in August and November respectively. In the entire academic session unit tests are held. Promotion of students to the next class is decided on the basis of his/her performance in all the exams & unit tests. The students' performance in the co-curricular & extra curricular activities also count in the promotion.

However, the promotion of the students is the sole prerogative of the Principal, which is decided on the basis of confidential reports of each student by the class teacher & subject teachers apart from his/her performance in examinations. Discipline of body & mind is the key to the success of the individual. The students of BISHOP GEORGE SCHOOL & COLLEGE are expected to be disciplined, dutiful and obedient to their teachers and lawabiding citizens of the country. Any misbehaviour with class mates or teachers is strictly penalized and repetition of prohibited acts/behavoiurs may result in the expulsion of the student.

For the purpose of discipline management in the school, a team of senior teachers and co-ordinators headed by the principal, ensures the students' compliance to the rules & regulations of the School.

The teachers should not only be the instruments of providing knowledge but they should also be the agents of change in the personality of the students. The teachers at BISHOP GEORGE SCHOOL & COLLEGE endeavor to in clucate the moral values, integrity and discipline in the students. The personal development of the students is the chief motive of the faculty. The teachers are well equipped with their specialized knowledge and believe in interactive learning.

Parents are regularly informed of their wards' performance in class tests, unit tests & examinations in the parents-teachers meeting which are regularly held on second Saturday of each month or on alternative day (if second Saturday happens to be a public Holiday)

The school has a modern well equipped computer laboratory to provide education in Computers according to ICSE curriculums. The student-machine ratio is well balanced so that each student gets ample opportunity to display their skills and acquire knowledge. Books are supposed to be individuals best friends and in the tender minds of students, the impact of great writers, philosophers & morals cannot the ignored. The students have access to school library during school hours and from coming session they shall be permitted to get the books issued for

Keeping in view the importance of English, in the competitive world, the school has a novel plan of educating the students even beyond the school premises to the home.



English, being the medium of instruction, is given importance and students are expected to converse in English during the school hours.

In Nursery classes, Toys, games pictures etc. supplement the traditionally ways of teaching. This is done with a view to make the learning process interactive and fun filled.

At Bishop George School & College, the students are exposed to a host of co-curricular & extra curricular activities. This is aimed at developing the pupil's personality and making the learning process better.

The school encourages the students to actively participate in excursions, debates, quiz contests, painting competitions etc. both of the school & interinstitutional functions.

The school has been organizing several symposiums & conclaves on Science & Commerce. Whereby the students get an ample opportunity to interact with the experts on various topics. In the session 2009-10, a science conclave 'INSPIRE-2010' was held in the College premises where renowned professors of HRI, Allahabad, delivered lectures on the mysteries of space & intricate aspects of physics...

The college principal Mr. Javed Bakht has been instrumental in giving the required thrust to the college & for this achievement he has been conferred with many awards & citations from International & National organisations.

Cultural programmes are held on the occasions of College Annual Day, Childrens' Day, Teachers' Day and Independence/Republic Day. It is the endeavor of the school to maximise the student's participation at all the levels in these programmes. The school won the runners-up trophy in the "Josephest" Cultural programme while competing with leading school of Allahabad. This festival was organised by St. Joshep's School.

The school believes in inculcating environment awareness among student so that they are aware of the importance of preserving nature and avoid doing things which causes pollution and wastage of natural resources, keeping all these things in mind the schools students have launched a "Green Club" who will educate other students about the hazardous effect of polythene bags, wastage of water, importance of planting trees, rain water harvesting etc.

The school also organise educational tours for children from time to time.
